02 MUSEU DE LES MINES DE BELLMUNT DEL PRIORAT

The Eugenia Mine made up of 20 underground floors. The guided tours take you to the first floor at about 35 m below the surface and the visitor walks 700 m of this first gallery.

03 MUSEU MIQUEL MONTAGUD

Miquel Montagud Museum is a collection of works taken from a museum formerly known as "The Echo d'El Greco". It is made up of reproductions of El Greco's works which were carried out by Miquel Montagud Borja (1897-1984).

04 PONT VELL

Bridge of mediaeval origin spanning the Montsant river (14th century) built with square blocks on bare rock. Span 38 m, 6 m high and 3 m wide. Stonemasons' marks are visible.



05 CASTLE OF FALSET REGIONAL MUSEUM

The Castle of Falset Regional Museum is a museum space that proposes the historical and cultural discovery of Priorat region in a pleasant, immersive and interactive way. From a careful selection of pieces, they show different aspects and moments of history covering a broad chronology.

06 MUSEU LULA PÉREZ-MARÇAGINÉ

This museum houses sculptures and other works by local artist Marçel·l Giné (1918-2006) and also those of his wife, Lula Pérez (1924-2004). The museum also houses a collection of pictorial art by the Marçà painter, Josep Sancho Piqué (1872-1959) from the twentieth century.

07 CENTRE D'INTERPRETACIÓ DE LA TORTUGA MEDITERRÀNIA

The Hermann tortoise sanctuary and visitor's centre is in magnificent natural setting for observing how examples of this species have been protected and are being bred to be returned to the wild. Visitors are also invited to delve into a world of aromas based on aromatic, medicinal and culinary herbs. A central avenue is covered with the local flora for visitors to enjoy. They are also offered the opportunity to observe the tortoises in their individual areas.

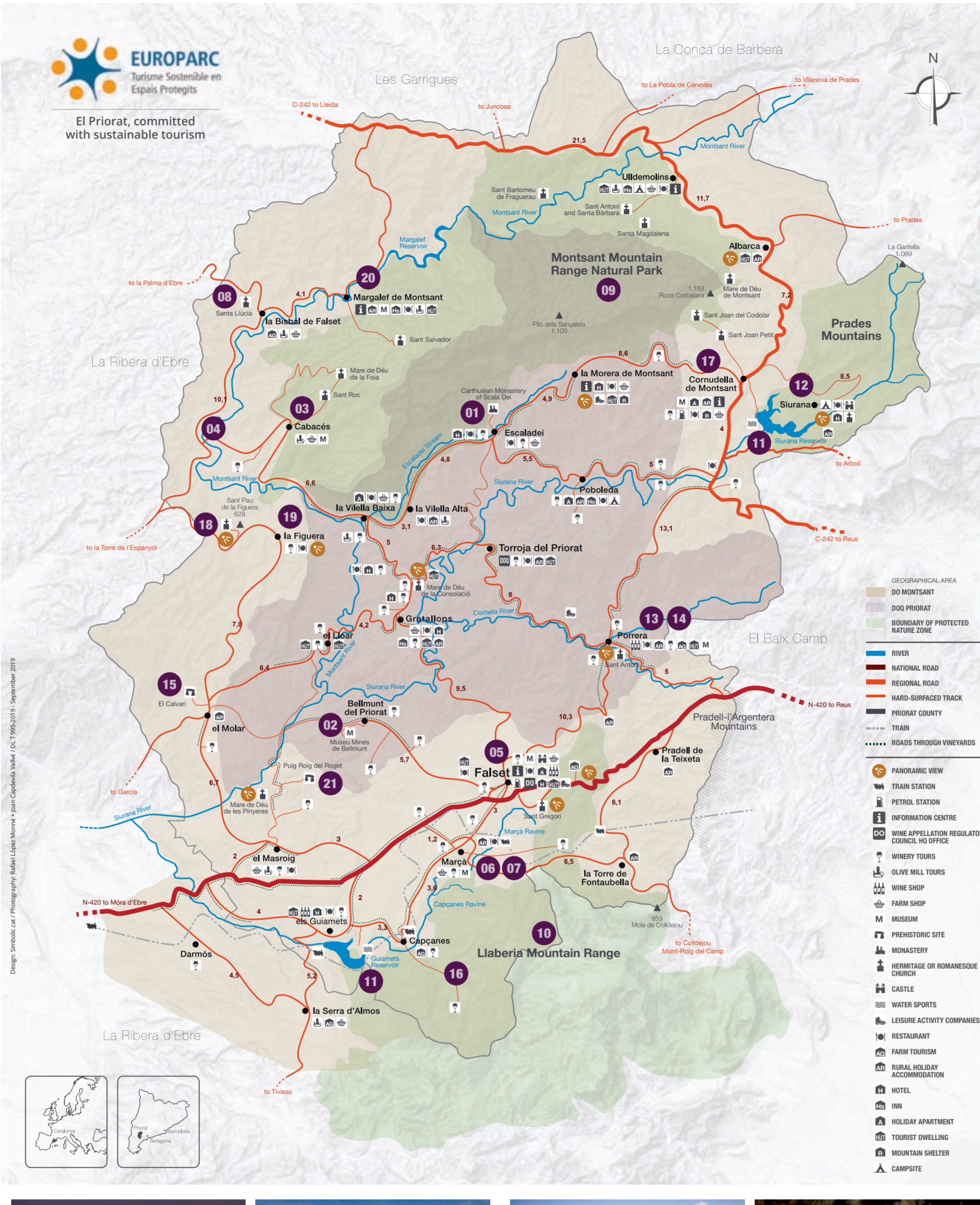

08 COVA DE SANTA LLÚCIA

This immense cave made out of conglomerate rock can be found at one kilometre from the village of La Bisbal de Falset on the road to La Palma d'Ebre. In July, 1938, a few days before the Battle of the Ebro began, the cave was prepared as a field hospital by the Republican troops.



09 SERRA DE MONTSANT

The Montsant Mountain Range was declared a Natural Park in 2002 and is regarded as a symbol of the Priorat and Tarragona province. This mountain range has sheer cliffs and rocky areas which are accessed via so-called "Graus". These "Graus" are passes in the rock which allow walkers through onto the uppermost plateau. Some of them are quite easy and broad as they were once used as packhorse trails to get from one village to another, whereas others are just wide enough for a person to pass in single file.

10 SERRA DE LLABERIA

More than mere mountains, the Llaberia and Collejou Mountain Ranges are fortresses: castles constricted by their steep cliffs and walls of limestone rock. Their characteristic shapes are an undeniable part of the countryside of the Priorat region and the Tarragona province.

The Priorat has been inhabited by hermits for many centuries. There are 16 hermitages which are scattered across the country in places of outstanding natural beauty. Many of these hermitages can be reached by car.



12 HISTORIC HAMLET AND OUTSTANDING VIEWS

This pretty hamlet, with cobbled streets and stone houses was once a defensive point and impassable border between the Christian and Islamic Worlds. Siurana was the last Moorish stronghold in Catalonia (it fell in 1153) and there are remains of the Moorish fortress at the entrance to the village as well as a beautiful 12th century Romanesque church.

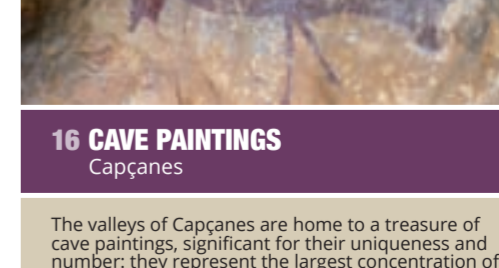

15 PREHISTORIC ARCHAEOLOGICAL REMAINS EL CALVARI

El Calvari is an archaeological site (7th-6th century BC) which is within the municipal boundaries of the village of El Molar. From El Molar, take the paved track signed El Calvari near to the crossroads with La Figuera and El Lloar. Follow it for 550 m.

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16 CAVE PAINTINGS

The valleys of Capçanes are home to a treasure of cave paintings, significant for their uniqueness and number: they represent the largest concentration of paintings - within a 2km radius - in all of Catalonia. There are 19 sites located in three gorges on the routes of Llaberia mountain range, of great artistic quality and astonishing subject matter.

17 ARXIU MORATÓ ARAGONÈS

The Morató Aragones Archive is a space devoted to the Reus-born painter Josep Maria Morató Aragones (b. Reus, 1923 - d. Barcelona, 2006), winner of the Gold Medal of the town of Reus and "Adoptive Son" of the village of Cornudella de Montsant. The archive has paintings, sketches and graphic work by the artist, as well as documentation from his personal archive.

18 OBSERVATORI DE LA BATALLA DE L'EBRE- ERMITA DE SANT PAU

500 m to the east of the Hermitage of Sant Pau (Saint Paul) lies the former command post (concrete trenches) of the Republican Army. This vantage point was used to plan the Battle of the Ebro in the spring of 1938.



19 EL BALCÓ DEL PRIORAT DEL COLL D'EN SOLANS

The Coll d'en Solans vantage point offers incredible views over the centre of the Priorat and the Montsant Mountain Range. At the cliff's edge, you will find a notice board with an explanation of the villages within view.



20 MOLÍ D'OLI DE MARGALEF. CENTRE D'INTERPRETACIÓ DE L'OLI

The Interpretation Centre for Olive Oil and Montsant Economic Produce also functions as an information point for the Natural Park. The restoration of an old olive oil mill has made it possible to learn about traditional methods for making olive oil, aiming to promote increased knowledge of olive oil, its culture and environment.

21 PREHISTORIC ARCHAEOLOGICAL REMAINS PUIG ROIG DEL ROGET

Puig Roig is an archaeological site which is within the municipal boundaries of the village of El Masroig. This historically important site is hidden in woodland and is perched on the top of a small hill with views over the Siurana river and Montsant Mountain Range. The site dates back to the ninth and seventh centuries B.C. and is one of the best preserved sites in Catalonia.
